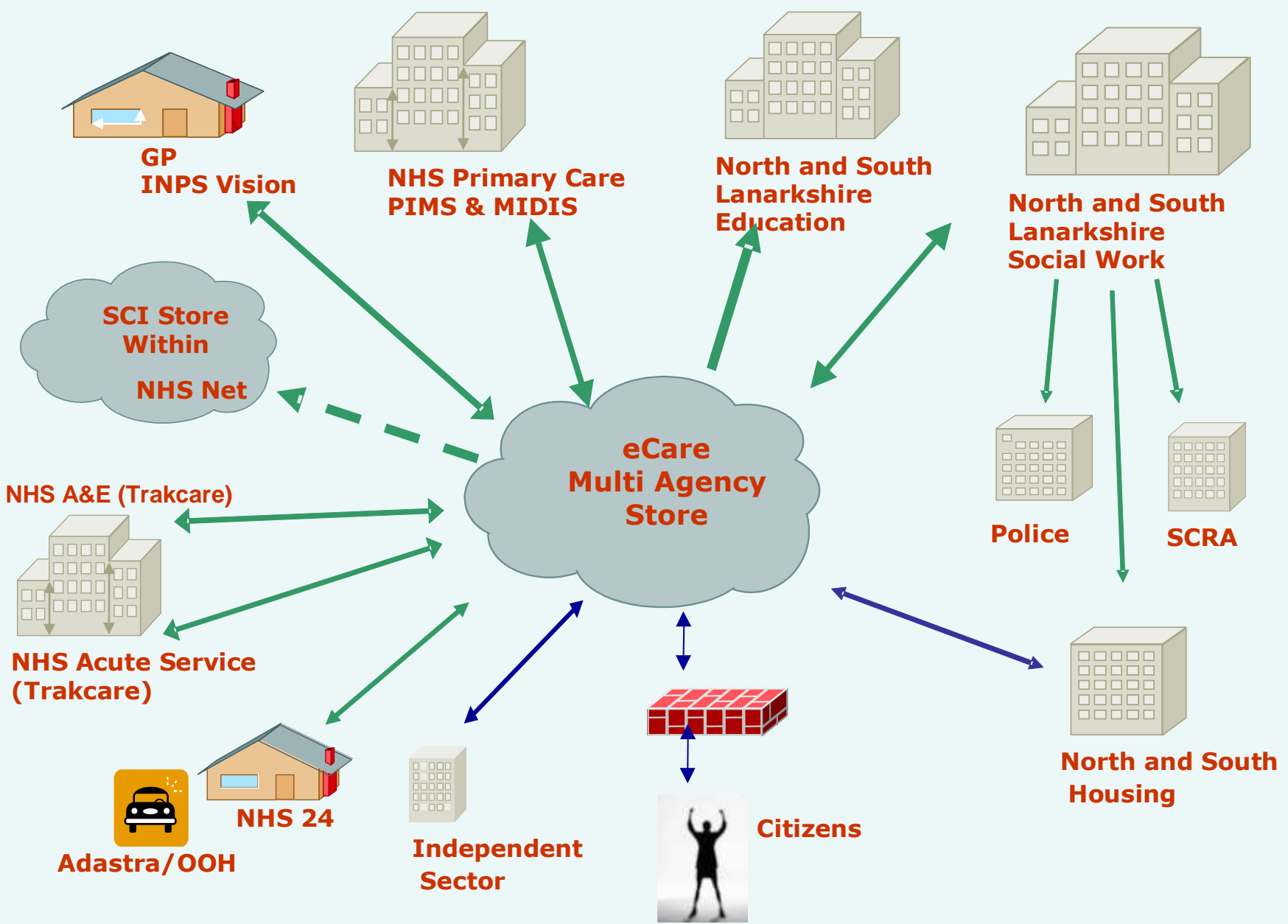

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Lanarkshire Information Sharing Protocol

A Trusted Model of Consent

One agency obtains consent for two or more agencies to share information

- Information Sharing Protocol – high level
- Obtaining Consent – Good Practice Guidance
- Consent form, Leaflets for Young People, Adults and Parents and Carers
- Multi agency training programme and training DVD
